

Dr. Denson Angulo Bass/Drum Studio Policy

Tuition: Lessons are priced as follows:

One single lesson is \$120/hr

Three-month package: \$90/hr 12 lessons \$360/month

Six-month package: \$80/hr 24 lessons \$320/month

One year mentorship program: \$70/hr 48 lessons \$280/month

I accept checks, cash and credit-cards/paypal/venmo. Returned checks will result in a \$50 fee.

Lessons are paid each month on or before the 1st of each month. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed on the 2nd of each month. You can pay for your selected pack in full, as well.

Lesson Attendance: Each student in the studio is entitled to four lessons each month, at the same time each week. If the student has a legitimate reason to cancel the lesson and I am given at least 24 hours advance notice, the student and I will arrange a make-up lesson. If a student does not give me the required advance notice (barring extenuating circumstances: IE injury, disaster, etc) the lesson will be paid for and there will be no make-up lesson. If a student misses two consecutive lessons without contacting me, they will forfeit their lesson package and the remaining amount will be due in full. No tuition refunds will ever be issued. In the event that I am unable to teach a lesson, I will (when possible) return the same courtesy of 24 hours advance notice when possible. In the event that there is a fifth lesson in a month, that lesson will be counted as a make-up lesson if it is required, or a “day off”. If a make-up is not required, the lesson is optional, upon student request, for the fee of whatever lesson package was selected. If a student is late, that is time that *they* have missed. I will not run any lesson past its scheduled time. This applies for Zoom or in-person.

Make-up lessons: If one or more lessons are missed during a monthly cycle, make up lessons will be done on an availability-of-schedule basis. Regularly scheduled lesson times will not be used as make-ups. Make-up lessons can be scheduled whenever the student and I can meet or can be held for a “5th day”. Credits toward preceding months will not be issued.

Illness: Please do not come to lessons if you are sick. If you are sick, we can use Zoom or do make-up lessons per the above section. Likewise, I will notify you if I am ill and a make-up lesson or Zoom lesson will be offered.

Practicing: Practicing is vital in the development of any skill, especially music. Practice may include anything that contributes to the learning of the bass. For example: listening to bassists, practicing scales, researching the history of pieces, listening to specific songs, focusing on new techniques during ensembles, etc. I will ask each student to report his/her practice time each week. Students who do not practice will be warned, then if the problem persists, they will be required to give up their lesson time to someone on the waiting list. No refunds will be issued.

Discontinuance of lessons: If you have purchased a lesson pack and are not going to renew, I must be notified at the beginning of the month of your final month in your pack. If you are discontinuing lessons and you are in the middle of a pack of lessons, the remaining lessons in your pack must be paid for, much like breaking a lease of an apartment.

Location/Parking: In-person lessons will be taught at my private home studio in Bluffdale, UT. Parking is permitted in designated areas. Contact me for details.

Zoom Lessons: For remote lessons via zoom, I need to be able to see and hear you well. An audio interface and quality web cam are highly recommended. Upon payment of your first month of lessons, I will give you the zoom room info. If you need assistance in getting things set up, I'm glad to do so before we meet.
